Superintendent Pelzel presented the following 2 learning models for Board consideration once school districts are permitted to return to face-to-face learning:

- Distance Learning Academy Model
- AM/PM Blended Learning Model

2020-2021 INSTRUCTIONAL PROGRAM OFFERINGS

Superintendent Pelzel also recommended a phase-in approach to bring back students as soon as districts are permitted to do so. By assigning students to their selected learning models, the District can quickly transition to an in-person setting without disruption and while maintaining stability.

The District is also partnering with its site childcare vendors to provide daily childcare. By subsidizing a portion of the cost, the District can support those families who have returned back to work. Our vendors have structures in place to support distance learning, student breaks and adhere to all social distancing and regulations.

NTA Co-President Hillary Hall along with several parents, teachers and members of the public addressed the Board on their concerns over returning or not returning to an in-person model.

Board members held discussions and shared their perspectives on the various learning model options for the fall. It was recommended Superintendent Pelzel confirm enrollment decisions in the two models with all parents and hold a chat session prior to school starting to further discuss the distance learning model structure with families.
