J. STAFF REPORTS

- 1. Staff Reports Business Services
 - i. Consideration of Approving the Purchase of Student Desks from Virco Equipment for Educators

After receiving updated guidance from the Los Angeles County Department of Public Health regarding the placement of student desks in classrooms, District staff researched various single desk options. Three options were presented to site administrators for feedback on sizing, shape and storage. The option presented today was the most recommended by staff. Desks are expected to arrive in late May/early June and should be assembled and ready for student-use at the start of the 2021-2022 year.

In response to questions from members of the public, Superintendent Pelzel shared that the purchase of single desks will be a long-term solution and positions the District to have the flexibility it may need in the future.

Updates in the County's guidance with student desks now positions the District to safely reopen schools for full-time, in-person learning Monday-Friday. After much discussion with District departments and site administrators, Superintendent Pelzel recommended the District move forward with full-time, in-person learning effective Monday, April 19, 2021.

Board members unanimously agreed that the single desk option is good, forwardthinking investment for the District. Board members also agreed to move forward with full-time in-person instruction beginning April 19, 2021. Communication to go out to all District families later today. Item approved.
