STAFF REPORTS

Administrative Services

Superintendent Pelzel shared COVID guidance recently released by the State COVID UPDATE regarding a new tiered framework, including rules of the framework and how they affect schools.

New California Department of Public Health (CDPH) guidelines will allow schools to provide limited in-person instruction for small cohorts and groups of children. Based on the guidelines. Student Support Services credentialed staff and service providers will be able to provide in-person assessments and specialized services to students with needs. The Instructional Services Department will also be able to administer

the mandated English Language Proficiency Assessment of CA (ELPAC) to English Learner students (ELs).

Student Support Services Director Kim Howe and Staff Development Administrator Kate Peattie shared how in-person services will be facilitated, including processes to ensure the District is following all safety guidelines and protocols.

NTA Co-President Hillary Hall and other District staff shared concerns and their perspectives on how to safely facilitate in-person services and assessments.

Board members discussed in length expectations for safety procedures and precautions. The Board also gave staff direction to create communication resources for families demonstrating how processes will be facilitated.

Approved moving forward with in-person assessments and specialized services for students with needs, and administer ELPAC assessments to EL students. Staff directed to provide regular feedback on processes and safety protocols.
