1. Staff Reports- Curriculum/Instructional Services

i. Newhall Creek Community Watershed Education and Restoration Project Lynne Plambeck from the Santa Clarita Organization for Planning and the Environment shared a grant was awarded for a watershed education and restoration project, which would include participation from students from McGrath, and Newhall Elementary Schools during their state-funded after-school program, RISE. Due to school closures, the project was not implemented. Funding for the project has recently been restored. However, due to funding delays, a timeline has yet to be determined.
