- Adequate infrastructure
- Classroom spaces connected for student flow
- Comfortable/flexible seating relevant to needs
- District office space (secure, adequate parking, Board room, technology)
- Electronic marques
- Elimination of portables
- Emergency supplies
- Functional
- HVAC in all classrooms
- Kitchens updated
- Innovation Lab/Makerspace
- MPRs updated sound systems, screens, eating areas
- Natural lighting

- Outdoor spaces for learning, gathering, physical activity
- Parent welcome centers community space
- Parking functional drop off and pick up; ample
- Performance spaces art, music, theater, dance, office, storage
- Professional development spaces for teachers
- Safety and security cameras, single point of entry, immediate lockdown, exterior lighting
- Storage
- Support services spaces (psychologists, counseling, speech)
- Technology (movable; consistent devices, hardware, software)
- Workspaces








Design Fundamentals – What are they?



Programmatic, functional, spatial, and environmental components that are essential for school facilities, whether these facilities are newly constructed or renovated.



How Do the Pieces Fit?



Why are Design Fundamentals Important?

- Convey universal features that should be considered when designing or re-imagining space in a school facility.
- Provide general guidelines relating to safety and security, sustainability, learning environments, circulation, furnishings, etc.
- Highlight optimal features/functions of interior/exterior spaces.
- Help District establish consistency and equity from site to site.
