Teachers Supporting Teachers

PROGRAM OVERVIEW

The SCV Consortium Teacher Induction Program provides a two year, job-embedded system of coaching, support, and professional learning for eligible teachers needing to complete a California Teacher Induction Program in order to obtain a Clear Credential.

The SCV Consortium Teacher Induction Program is a California accredited teacher induction program which serves both General Education and Special Education teachers holding preliminary Multiple Subject, Single Subject, and/or Education Specialist credentials.

PROGRAM REQUIREMENTS

Candidates must:

Hold a valid *Preliminary* California Teaching Credential

Be employed in a teaching position as the teacher of record

Attend program meetings and relevant professional development

Develop and implement an Individual Learning Plan, completing all milestones and program surveys

Collaborate and meet weekly with a Mentor Teacher

HOW DO TEACHERS BENEFIT FROM THE SCV CONSORTIUM TEACHER INDUCTION PROGRAM?

- The program supports new teachers in obtaining their Clear Credential(s) and provides them with weekly one-on-one support and guidance from a trained and supportive Mentor Teacher.
- Teachers with two or more years of *exceptional* teaching experience may be eligible to apply for the *Early Completion Option*, which is an accelerated program. **Please note, application to the ECO Program is not a guarantee of acceptance and approval.*
- Participation in Induction is an opportunity to earn university credit toward a Master's degree and/or salary advancement through our university partners.
- The fees (if applicable) for participation in the SCVCTIP are significantly lower than university induction programs (\$2,000-\$2,500/year). Be sure to inquire with your employer to see if they cover the cost of induction for their teachers.
- *All candidates holding a Preliminary Credential are eligible to participate in the SCV Consortium Teacher Induction Program (SCVCTIP) regardless of race, religion, color, national origin, ancestry, age, marital status, pregnancy, mental disability, physical disability, medical condition, genetic information, veteran status, gender, gender identity, or any other characteristic protected by state or federal law.*



PROGRAM OPPORTUNITIES

Mentor Teachers

Experienced teachers apply and are selected by site and District administrators to be trained and serve as Mentor Teachers for Participating Teachers throughout their Induction journey.

Standards and Research-Based

The *California Standards for the Teaching Profession*, the *Common Core State Standards*, and the California Induction Program Standards are the foundation for support activities and trainings.

Professional Learning and Collaboration

Participating Teachers and Mentors have a variety of opportunities for collaboration with peers, professional learning, and training in best teaching practices.
