



Dear Staff,

The Healthy Schools Act of 2000 was signed into law in September 2000 and requires that all schools provide staff with annual written notification of expected pesticide use on school sites. We intend to apply pesticide once a year during the summer when students and staff are on summer break, if needed. The Newhall School District has developed an Integrated Pest Management Plan and we will first use non-chemical methods of pest management during the school year.

If, in any given situation, non-chemical methods of pest management are ineffective and it is deemed necessary to use a pesticide during the school year, the school site will be placarded in advance, as required by law. The pesticides we use are TERMIDOR SC, and its active ingredient is Fitronil, and Demand CS, and its active ingredient is Lambda-Cyhalothrin. Additionally, a registry of staff who wish to be personally notified of any pesticide applied at their school will be kept by the District.
