It is important for all certificated staff and management to understand the purpose of our PLC meeting times.*

Professional learning community meeting times are designated for teacher collaboration to analyze data, examine student performance on formative, summative, and grade level assessments, and to design, refine, and reorganize teaching and intervention efforts. It is time to examine student work samples to improve student learning and guide instruction. Planning curriculum, sharing best practices and instructional methods, gathering needed materials, and creating grade level assessments to evaluate student performance, and cross grade level articulation is also a good use of the meeting time.
