



**THE NEWHALL SCHOOL DISTRICT IS SEEKING ONE  
MEMBER OF THE COMMUNITY TO ASSIST THE SCHOOL  
DISTRICT BY SERVING ON ITS MEASURE E CITIZENS'  
OVERSIGHT COMMITTEE**

On November 8<sup>th</sup>, 2011 voters within the Newhall School District expressed their support for public education by passing Measure E. Measure E, a general obligation bond, is proposed to help modernize, renovate and revitalize our schools. Funds generated from the authorized bonds will be used for a variety of school district capital projects. These projects will help the District in meeting its educational goals to educate the students in our community.

The District formed a Citizens' Oversight Committee, comprised of specified members of the community to assist the District in reviewing the expenditure of bond funds as they have occurred. The Committee included at least seven members of the community who were appointed by the Governing Board of the School District. Currently, the District is looking to fill one vacancy.

Service is without compensation and the Committee is expected to meet at least quarterly. Service on the Committee is a good opportunity for interested members of the community to learn more about the District and its facilities plans and is an opportunity for members of the community to support the District and its mission of public education. Employees of the district and vendors, consultants and contractors who work for, or provide services to, the district may not serve on the Committee. Members of School District PTAs, PTOs, Site Councils, and foundations are encouraged to apply.

Applications for membership on the Committee must be submitted on the District's Citizens Oversight Committee (COC) Application Form. Applications submitted not using the Application Form may not be considered. The Application Form is available upon request and can be downloaded from the Newhall School District Website at [www.newhallschooldistrict.com](http://www.newhallschooldistrict.com). The deadline to submit a completed Application Form is 4:30 PM on January 25, 2019. FAXed applications will not be accepted. Applications submitted or received after the deadline may not be considered. Please note that under State law, the District cannot hold the completed Applications as confidential documents.

The selection process for Committee applicants may include an interview by the Governing Board or a subcommittee thereof. Final selection and appointment of the new members of the Committee is expected by February 12, 2019.
