


Balter-Kindergarten Asynchronous Activities During District Internet Outage- September 17, 2020

Subject	Kindergarten <i>180 minutes</i>
ELA	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> * Have a caregiver read “School Rules” from your Friday Folder packet. *Reread it for the second time with echo reading (where the caregiver reads part of the story and the student repeats). * Writing: Practice writing your days of the week (using the worksheet in your materials picked up last week or on a lined sheet of paper). *Extension: Write your numbers as high as you can on a separate lined sheet of paper. <p><i>-50 minutes</i></p>
Math	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> * Using your toys, practice sorting objects by color! *If you finish early, can you sort your objects in a different way? (For example, toy cars and stuffed animals). <p><i>-30 minutes</i></p>
Social Studies	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> *In your Friday Folder from last week, you received a Social Studies packet. Have a caregiver read the packet to you and follow along. <p><i>-30 minutes</i></p>
Science	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> *Create a 5 senses scavenger hunt. Find one thing that sounds good, one thing that feels good, and one thing that looks good to you. Talk to a caregiver about why you like them. Draw a picture of each thing that you find on your scavenger hunt. <p><i>-30 minutes</i></p>
PE	<p>Play the Freeze Game, play music and when the music stops you must freeze in place. You can play with your family or facetime with a friend. -20 minutes</p>
Art	<p>In our morning meeting, we talk about weather! Look out your window. What does the weather outside look like today? Draw a picture on a blank sheet of paper in your materials! -20 minutes</p> <div style="text-align: center;">  </div>
