Subject	Transitional Kinder <i>180 minutes</i>
ELA	<p>*Using a blank sheet of lined paper, practice writing your name in one color! Keep writing your name on different lines using different colors in your crayon box. With a caregiver, tell them the names of all the colors you used.</p> <p>*Using your materials picked up last week, complete the two worksheets for the letter C!</p> <p>-50 minutes</p>
Math	<p>*In your materials that you picked up last week, you have a play mat that is a laminated sheet of paper. Use this mat to play with your play-doh! Your play-doh is in your Finding Nemo pencil case (also picked up last week).</p> <p>* With your play doh, make the shapes we use in our Number Corner: a circle, a triangle, a rectangle, and a square. </p> <p>*If you finish early, you can use your mat to practice counting from 1-10 with pieces of play-doh.</p> <p>-30 minutes</p>
Social Studies	<p>*We talk about our emotions every day! Using a sheet of paper, draw something that makes you happy, something that makes you angry, and something that makes you sad.</p> <div style="text-align: right;">  </div> <p>-30 minutes</p>
Science	<p>*Go on a color scavenger hunt with your toys for each of the colors of the rainbow: red, orange, yellow, green, blue, and purple. Draw a picture of each toy on a blank sheet of paper. Have an adult help you label each toy.</p> <p>-30 minutes</p>
PE	<p>*Play to develop curiosity, problem-solving, intentionality, flexibility and verbal and non-verbal skills by playing independently and in a small group.</p> <p>– at least 20 minutes</p>
