What is an **FIEP**

- Facilitated Individualized Education Program (IEP) meetings are:
 - Collaborative sessions involving parents, educators, and specialists
 - Decision- making is managed through the use of facilitation skills



The Process enables the team to:

- Build and improve strong relationships
- Reach true consensus throughout the process
- Focus on the needs of the student
- Exercise efficiency
- Guides the meeting with effective communication





The Purpose of using the FIEP process

- Guides IEP members toward the objectives
- Assists in building understanding and agreement
- Resolves conflict
- Improves time management
- Enables parents to receive information ahead of the meeting and come to the IEP prepared with questions
- Addresses concerns
