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UNIVERSAL PRE-KINDERGARTEN (UPK)



What is UPK?

Universal Pre-Kindergarten (UPK) or Transitional Kindergarten (TK) is a free Pre-Kindergarten program where children learn together through play and develop their social skills. All four-year-old children are eligible for UPK the year before entering Kindergarten. UPK is free of charge as part of California's public school system.

Starting in the 2025-26 school year, all children who turn four by September 2 are eligible for UPK.

What does a typical UPK day look like?

UPK teacher Amy Freidin from Stevenson Ranch Elementary has taught for 29 years in the Newhall School District and 13 years in UPK. Ms. Freidin shares, "I am so lucky to have the privilege to teach UPK in the Newhall School District. Universal Pre-Kindergarten (UPK) serves as the vital bridge between preschool and kindergarten. Our goal is to provide every child with a strong start regardless of their prior experience. We embrace a play-based approach to teaching our youngest learners offering hands-on activities that foster growth in social, emotional and academic areas. A typical day in the classroom includes: circle time, literature, small group and whole group reading and math, integrated lessons in social studies and science, art, and opportunities for both indoor and outdoor play. When you step into a UPK classroom, you'll be welcomed by the joyful sounds of children engaged in learning and discovery."
